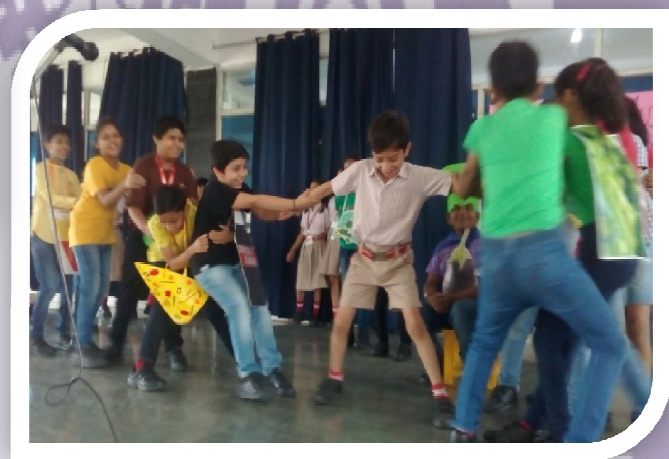

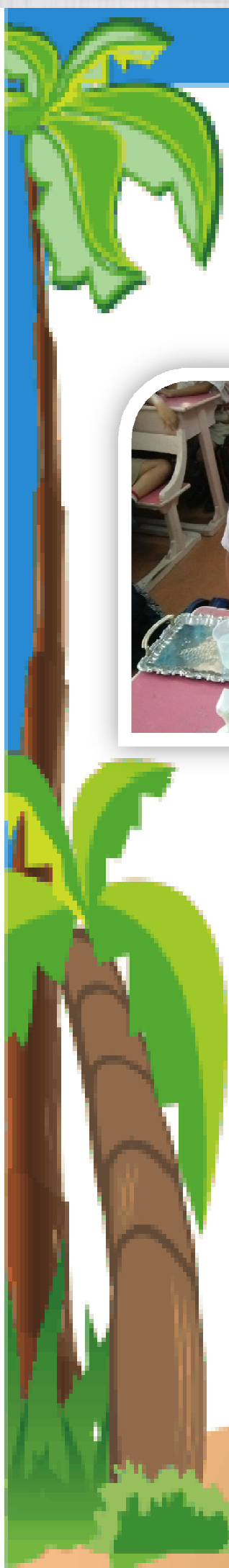
EARTH DAY

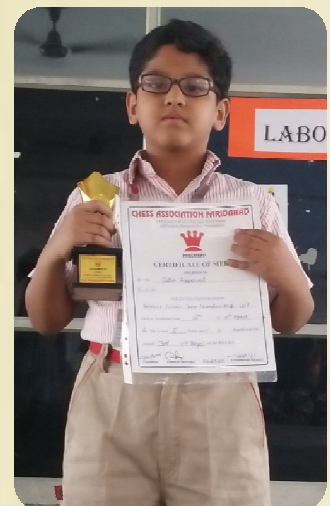

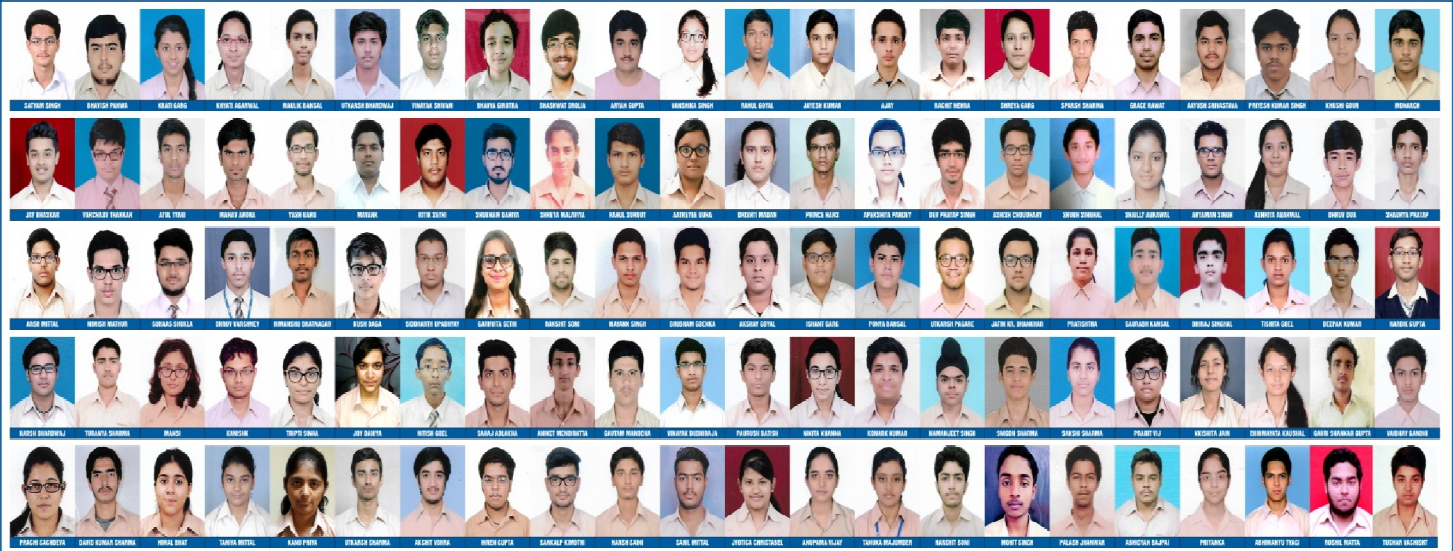

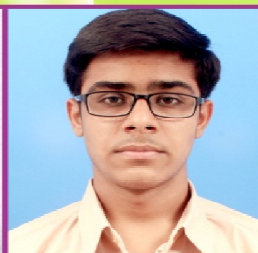
