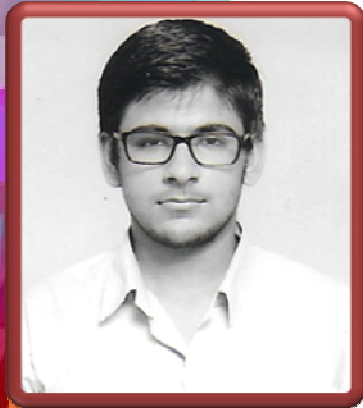


CBSE REGIONAL LEVEL SCIENCE EXHIBITION

ARYABHATTA INTER SCHOOL MATHEMATICS COMPETITION

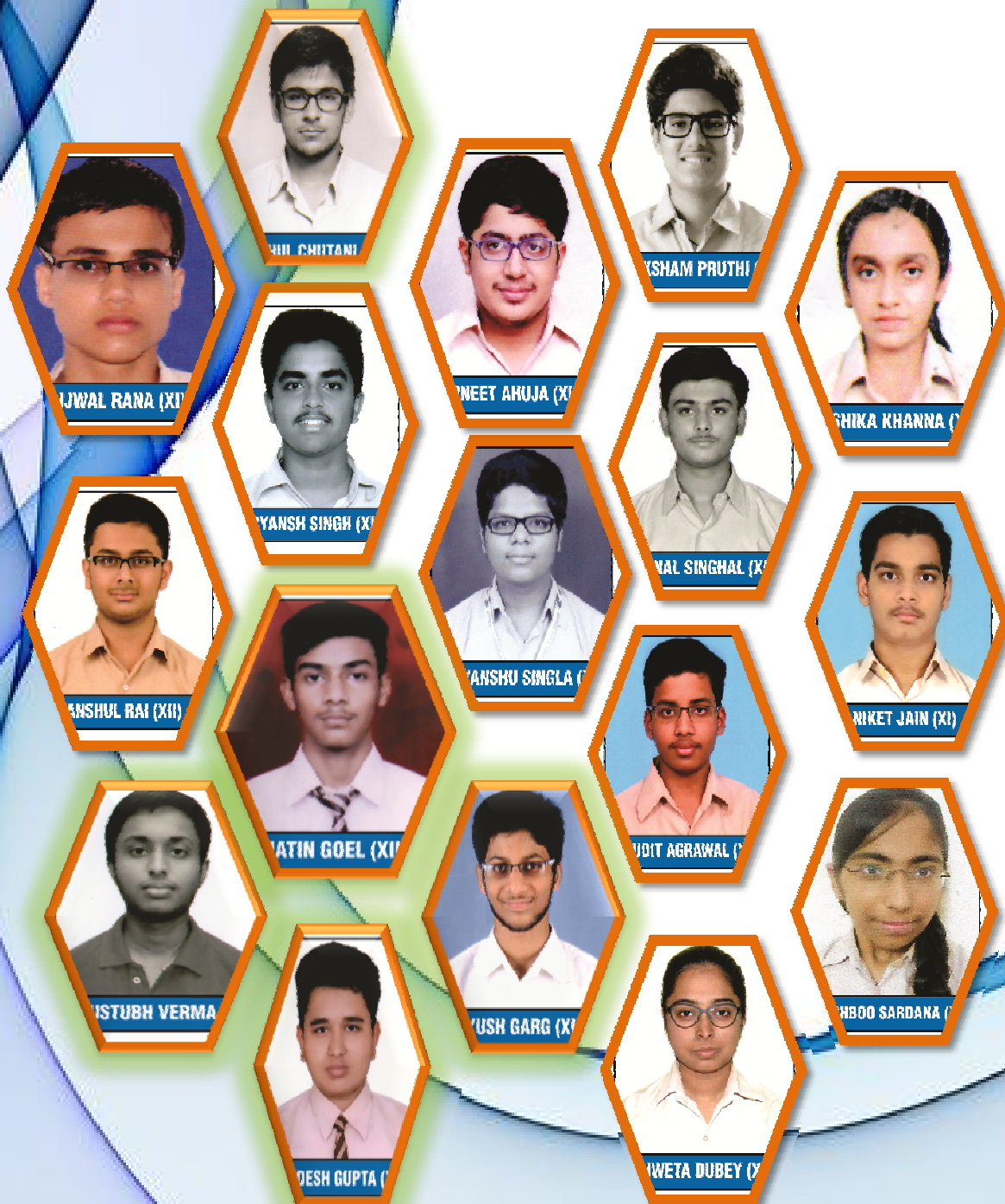


