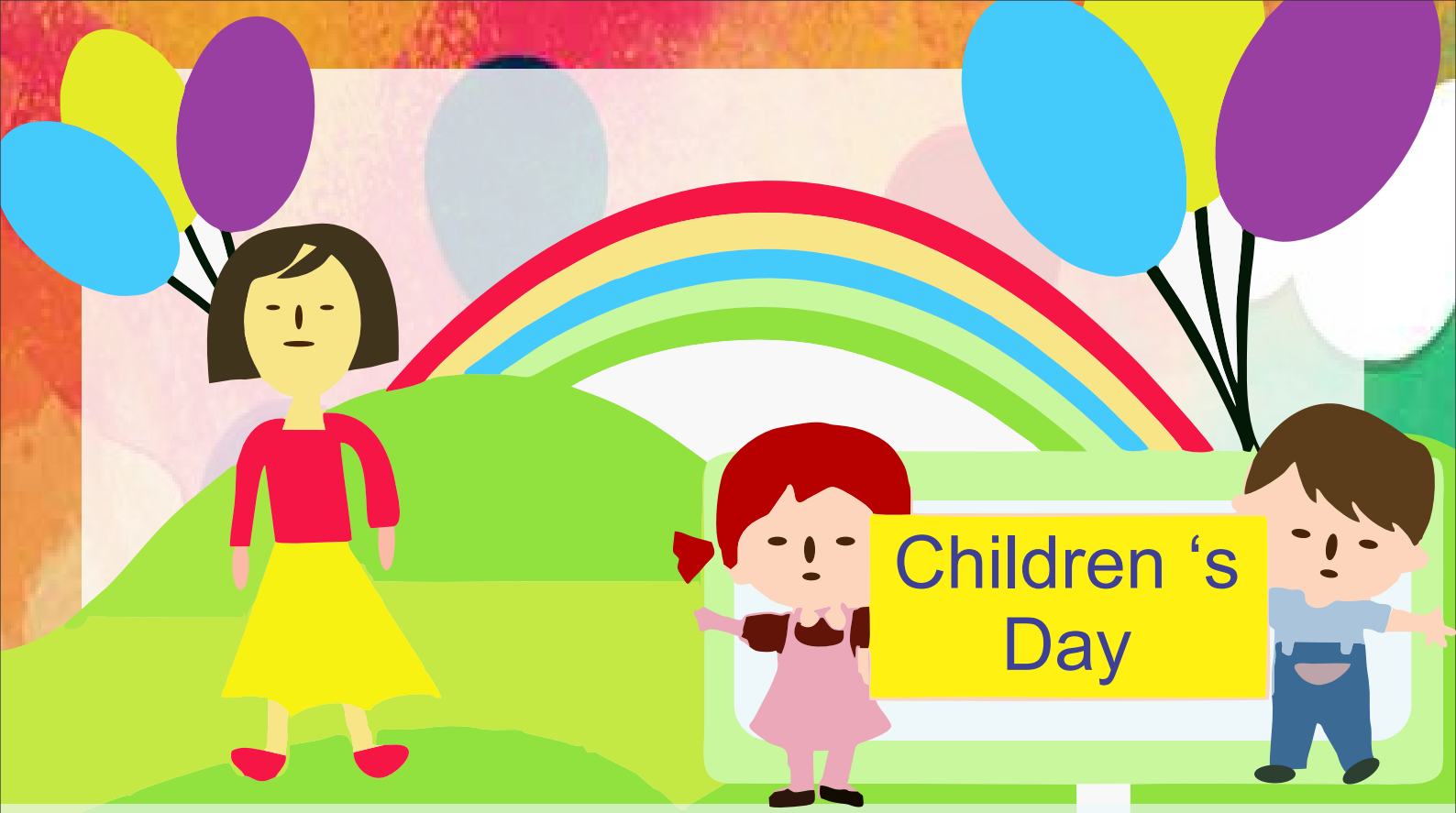




Gurupurab

Christmas Day



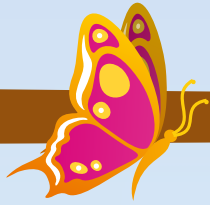

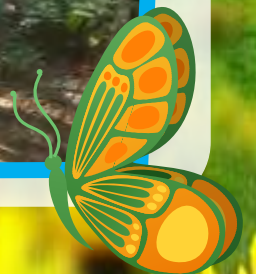


Outing & Field Trips

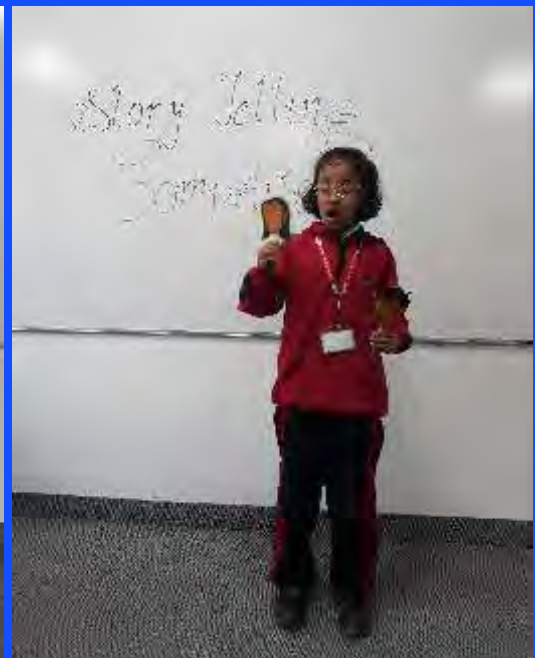
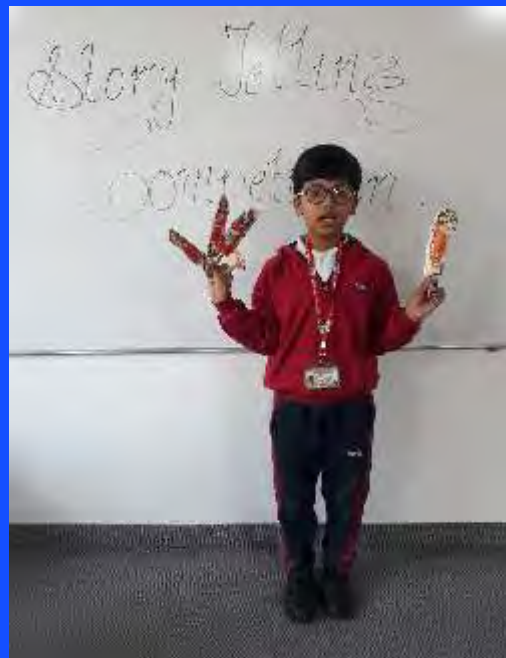
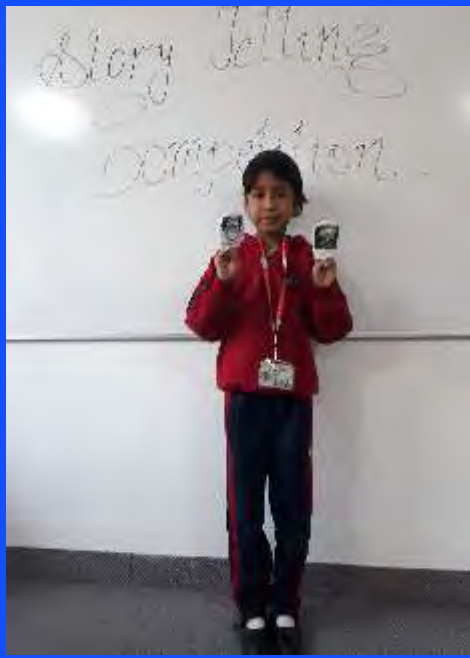
