
Help Others and Be Kind

"Reach high, for stars lie hidden in you.


Dream deep, for every dream precedes the goal."

Through engaging activities like role play and meaningful discussions, it aimed to instill lifelong habits of vigilance and responsibility in young learners.












WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

"Yoga is the journey of the self through the self, to the self"


Our students celebrated International Yoga Day in a unique and fun way! Despite being at home, they joined together in spirit to practice yoga and share their experiences with us.




































BOOK WEEK DAY 4 & 5




















BOOK WEEK: SPECIAL STORY SESSION


