The assembly served as a harmonious blend of devotion and enlightenment, aligning the school community with the sacred traditions and values embodied in the Consecration Ceremony.








BE PUNCTUAL

The assembly commenced with the invocation of Lord almighty and was a delightful amalgamation of thought, speech, poems and song performance.








REPUBLIC DAY






















HEALTH IS WEALTH

VASANT PANCHAMI



These activities not only enhanced the creative skills of our young learners but also motivated them to showcase their talents with confidence.




















"FROM FIFTH GRADERS TO FUTURE LEADERS: LAST DAY FUN BEGINS!"
