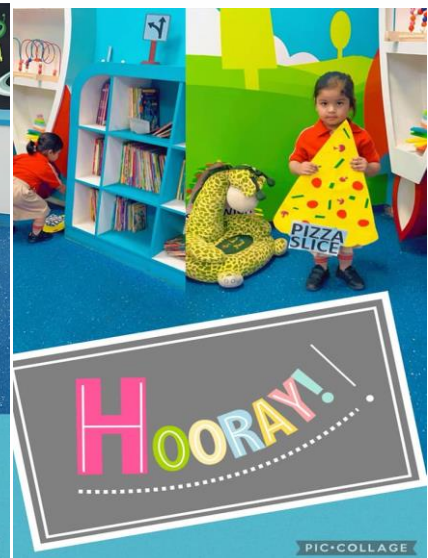
They used their observation skills, fine motor skills and cognitive skills to observe the various plants and flowers in the park and learnt about their different textures, shapes and sizes.

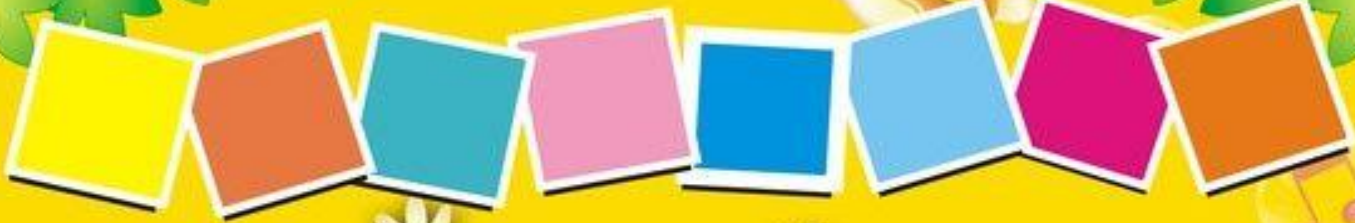

The theme of World Health Day this year is "Building a Healthier Future Together," emphasizing the importance of collective efforts in addressing the challenges that impact our health and well-being.

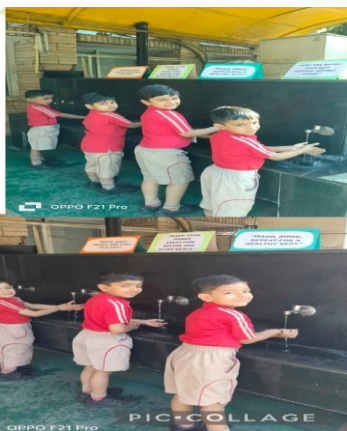

INTERNATIONAL DANCE DAY

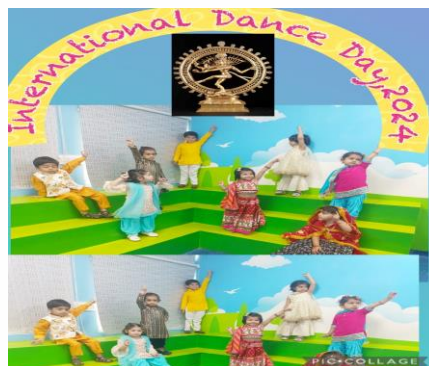

MOTHER'S DAY

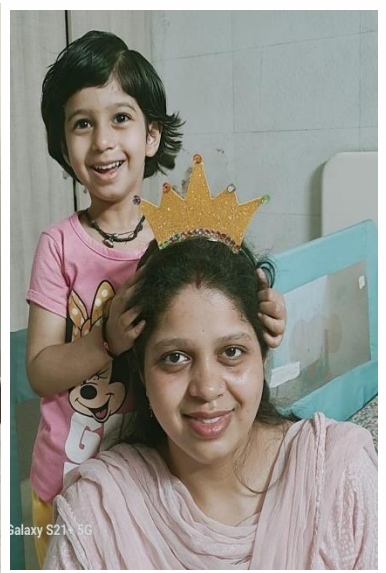
"The influence of a mother in the lives of her children is beyond calculation." — James E. Faust

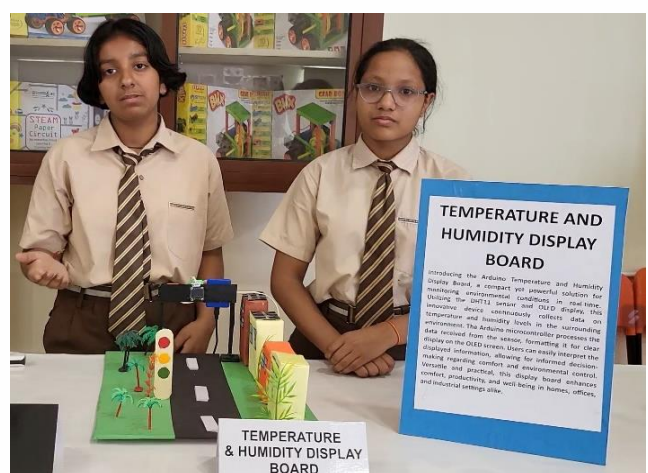
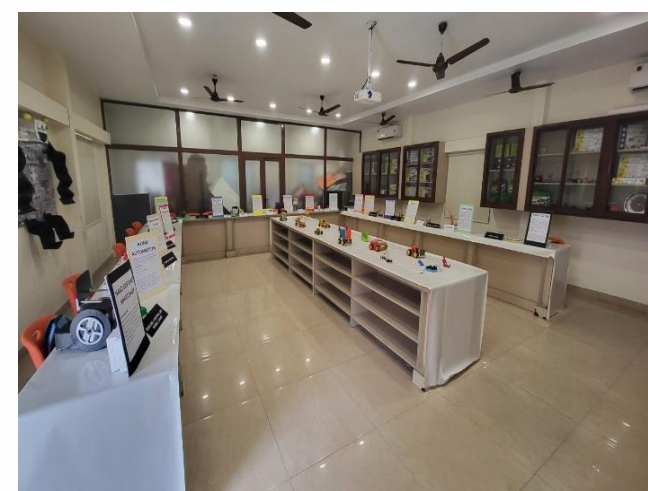
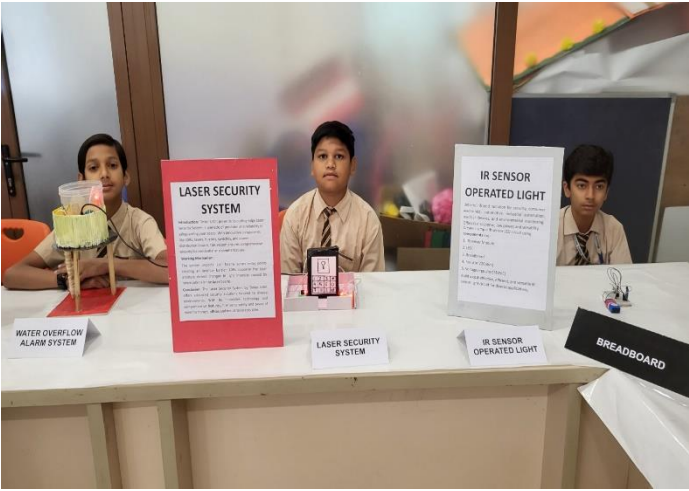


ROBOTICS EXHIBITS

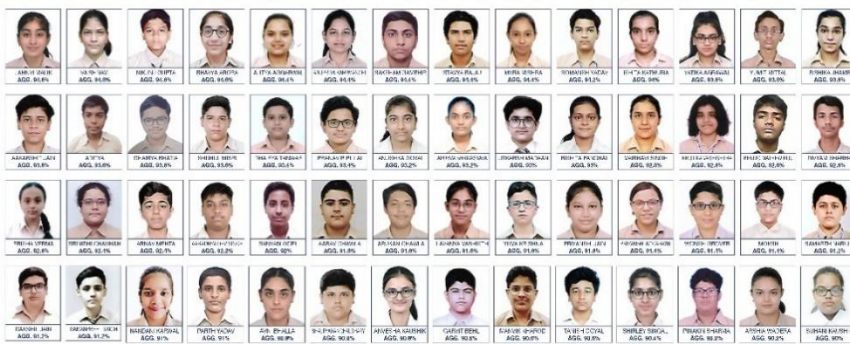
