






























LANGUAGE ADVENTURE




ALL AROUND SOUND

WATER IS EVERYWHERE



Our little explorers dived into the fascinating world of water sources! From rivers to lakes, oceans to rain, Little kindergarteners discovered how important water is for all living things.



Little kindergarteners also learnt the importance of conservation of water and how we should never waste water. Every drop counts!


